FOUR YEAR COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

- English 4 years
(Literature/Composition/Speech)
- Social Studies 4 years
- Math 3 years (4 years for selective)
(Algebra/Geometry/Algebra II)



FOUR YEAR COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

- Science 3 years (4 years for selective)
(Physical/Biology/Chemistry or Physics)
- World Language 2 years (3-4 years for selective)
- Fine or Performing Arts 1 year



FOUR YEAR COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

- Honors/AP Coursework (selective)
- 70th Percentile Class Rank or Better (selective)



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CFHS

24 CREDITS MINIMUM

- English 4 credits

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CFHS

 - World History or AP World History
 - Economics
 - Human Geography or AP Government



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CFHS

24 CREDITS MINIMUM

- Math 3 credits
 - **Intermediate Algebra or Algebra II**
 - Algebra II
 - Geometry

24 CREDITS MINIMUM

- Science 3 credits
 - **Physical Science**
 - Biology
 - Chemistry or Physics

ELECTIVE CLASSES

- Your child may have the opportunity to select electives.
- It is a good time to look at a world language – keep in mind that if you struggle with English, a world language will be more difficult.



ELECTIVE CLASSES

- Make sure you select several alternative elective courses. We register seniors first, so sometimes elective classes do not have room for freshmen. If you do not provide alternative elective courses, those may be chosen for you.

VISUAL ARTS

- **Art I**

- This is a prerequisite for most of the art classes students are allowed to take in grades 10-12
- One semester

- **Drawing and Design I**

- Students may be allowed to take this course with permission from the instructor
- One semester



WORLD LANGUAGES

- **Spanish I**
 - This course is taught at CFHS
 - Students should have a grade of “C” in their current English course
 - Most state colleges want students to have at least two (2) years of a world language for admission
 - Two (2) semesters/full year



WORLD LANGUAGES

- **Chinese I**
 - Chinese I is an ITV course
 - Two (2) semesters
- **Other world languages may be available in an online format.**



MUSIC

- **Concert Band**
 - This is made up of students in grades 9-12
 - Concert Band meets every day
 - Two (2) semesters/full year



MUSIC

- **Mixed Choir**
 - This choir is made up of students in 9th grade.
 - Mixed Choir meets every day
 - Two (2) semesters/full year
- **Concert Choir**
 - This choir is made up of students in grades 10-12
 - Concert Choir meets every day
 - Two (2) semesters/full year



REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Before Registration begins, the school counselor will be in one of the 8th grade classrooms to explain the process.
- Students will get a Registration Form to review and have completed in time for their course registration during their English class.
- Students will be walked through accessing the Registration Handbook online.



FOUR YEAR PLAN

- Credit Check Worksheet is in the Registration Handbook (Page 5).
- Look at classes and their prerequisites so that you can plan ahead.
- Be careful. Some classes are offered on a rotation and not available every year.
